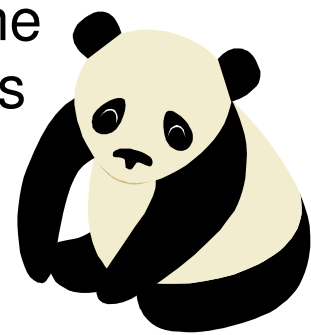




BLUE PETER BADGES FOR YEAR FIVE
